Connected by the QEW and Highways 403 and 407, as well as three GO Transit stations, Burlington is highly accessible. Did you know, it takes just 41 minutes to drive to Toronto? Burlington's proximity to the US border further enhances its desirability. The city is within short driving distance of several international airports, including Toronto's Pearson International.








Burlington Rental Market




