THRIVING CONNECTIVITY

Whether you bike, walk, drive or take public transportation, there are many ways to explore the city or get to where you need to be. Calgary is also home to the most extensive outdoor pathway and dedicated bike path network in North America. Home to over 1,000 kilometres of paved multi-use pathways with dozens of communities linked by the pathway system. The city also has another 290 kilometres of on-street bikeways, including dedicated bike lanes downtown.

Even if you have a vehicle, public transit is the way to go when getting around downtown. We recommend taking the CTrain, as it is affordable and easy to use. If walking is more your style, you can take the Plus15, which is a network of over 86 bridges and over 16 km of elevated, weather-protected and climate controlled walkways. Enabling pedestrian mobility, and providing views of the city. Want to try something a little more fun? Shared e-Scooters and e-Bikes are a great way to get to make your way throughout the city. You can ride a e-Scooter city-wide on bicycle lanes, pathways, empty sidewalks and roadways with lower speed limits and lower traffic volumes.

Take in a view of the city skyline with a ride to Scotsman's Hill. Try biking the paved pathways to Prince's Island Park, exploring the island & admiring the inner-city wildlife including Canada geese and mallard ducks. Want to explore more of downtown? Bike one of the many bike lanes, or cycle tracks that provide a physical barrier from cars and sidewalks. Kick your adventure into high gear and explore Calgary on one of the countless bike paths that wind through some of the city's highlights, stunning parks and nature reserves. With over 900 kilometres of pathways and 400 kilometres of on-street bicycling routes, there is no shortage of choice for biking paths—whether you are a beginner or a road warrior. Missing the gear? Don't fear -Bike rentals are available at Bow Cycle & Sports, U of C Outdoor Centre, or Prince's Island Park!























WINE & DINE
















OLYMPIC PLAZA

An exceptional collection of art and historical objects that explore historical and contemporary art, fashion, design and innovation from around the world.


DEVONIAN GARDENS 333 7^{TH} AVENUE S.W.



THE ROCKY MOUNTAINS




