

As Calgary's only multi-family, master-planned community with direct access to the LRT, it's time to say so long to traffic jams, finding parking spots, and rushing to get where you're going.





Big business, sky-high towers, a happening scene & riverside walks – all connected at the Core.



Built 15 feet above ground, connected to over 100 buildings and 60 suspended bridges, the +15 Skywalk is the largest covered pedestrian network strolling 18km through the downtown core. Here's our top high five spots along the way.

- 1 Shop till you drop at The Core Shopping Mall an epicentre with over 160 upscale retailers, restaurants, and services to tempt every taste.
- 2 Enjoy a little urban oasis at Devonian Gardens, an enormous indoor park and botanical garden featuring over 500 trees, 50 varieties of plants, a 900 sq. ft. living wall, fountains, fishponds, and playground.
- **3** For the love of art, Glenbow Museum celebrates a diverse expression of art, film, and cultural collections.
- 4 Look up at The Bow, one of the tallest towers in Canada and among the top 10 architectural projects in the world.
- **5** Get the best of the 360° views of the city skyline, the majestic Rocky Mountains, the foothills, and the prairies up top the 191 metre Calgary Tower.


From the historic to hip, and artful to playful, downtown Calgary celebrates diverse culture.


Calgary City Hall/Central Library

Olympic Plaza

Originally built for the 1988 Winter Olympic medal ceremony, the now-public green space features paved walking paths, sculptures, water fountains, and a wading pool that becomes an outdoor skating rink in the winter.
