### MASTER-PLANNED COMMUNITY


### EXPERIENCE SOUTH-ETOBICOKE

South Etobicoke is filled with many local amenities that residents will enjoy right in their own backyard. Humber Bay Shores is only 4 kilometres away and will give residents the opportunity to kayak, paddle board, sail or canoe on the river. The Etobicoke Yacht Club and Mimico Cruise Club are nearby as well. The Old Mill bridge is a great spot for hikers and nature lovers. The bridge is a heritage landmark built in 1916, it displays rustic stones and shows off the rich history in the neighbourhood.



### **OUTSTANDING LOCATION**

This area offers many shops, boutiques, salons, dining options, cafes, bars and grocery stores within walking distance. This site is close to the Gardiner Expressway and can get commuters to the downtown core in a quick 20 minutes. Additionally, highway 427 and the QEW are nearby, allowing drivers to get in and out of the city quickly and efficiently. Mimico GO Station is a quick 8 minute drive away and will take residents to Union Station in 15 minutes. To add to this quick service, Metrolinx recently announced that they will be adding a new Park Lawn GO Station, this proposed station will lie between Humber Bay and Mimico, taking commuters to the downtown core even quicker.
