

FIRE PIT


Snuggle up with a friend or family around the fire pit and share the day's feats and foibles. Reservations required.

Go mountain biking or hike the nature trails near Muskoka Bay Resort and immerse yourself in timeless beauty.




FOUR-SEASON LIVING

Kahshe, Sparrow, and Three Mile lakes beckon early morning fishers with perch, walleye, and sunfish. After an afternoon game of tennis on the resort's professional court, venture to Torrance Barrens Dark Sky Reserve in Gravenhurst and look up in wonder at the aurora borealis.







WINTER FUN







CLIFFSIDE RESTAURANT & TERRACE


POOLSIDE DINING







WORLD-CLASS CLIFFTOP CLUBHOUSE
